VIDEO DESIGN CREATIVITY	Project shows much original thought. Ideas are creative and inventive.	Project shows some original thought and creativity. VIDEO DESIGN QUALITY	Mastery in choice of colors, textures, and shapes to create realistic images . Mastery in creation of movement with smooth/realistic movement .
